

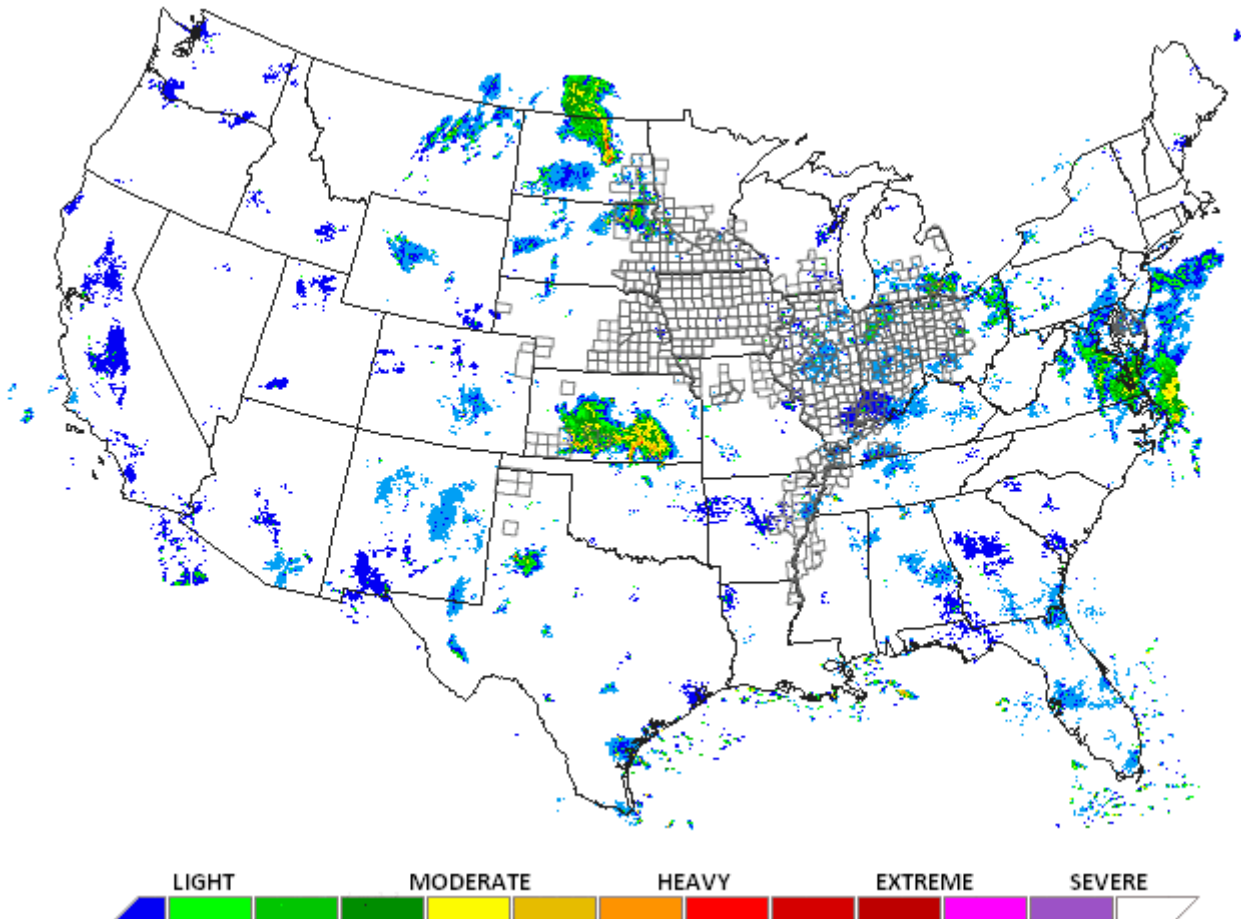

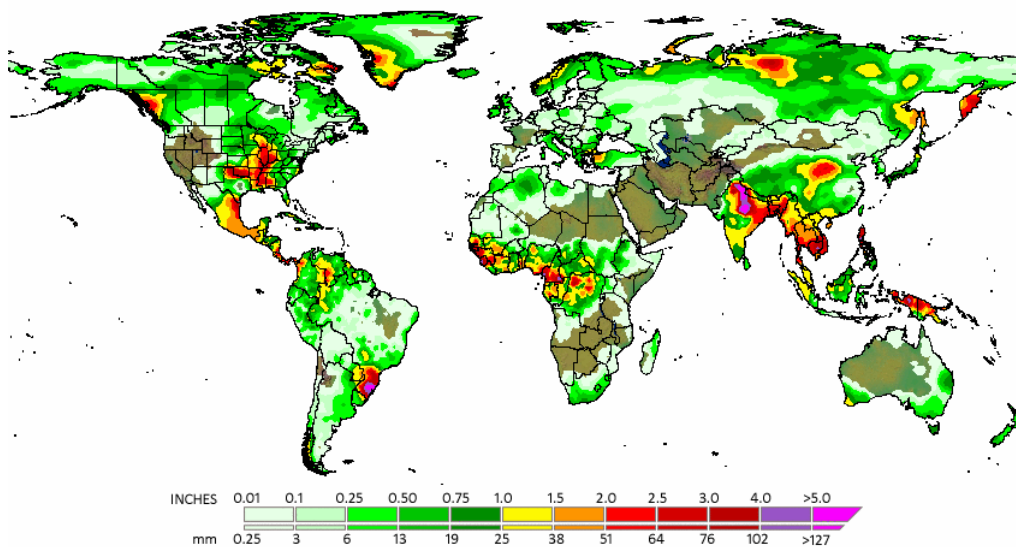

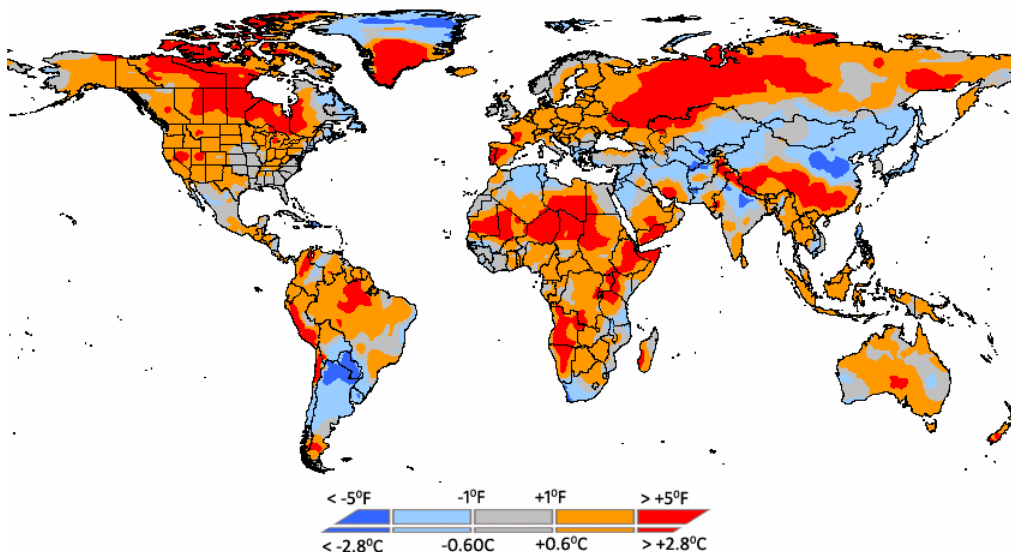
COMMENTS

Following last week's slide, grains/oilseeds should start off the shorter trading week stronger. Corn closed last week at a three year low, and soybeans are showing their first gains in the last week. Most eyes are on currency as a weaker USD should spur buying from overseas buyers. Most crop reports from last week focused on favorable August weather helping yields for corn and beans; in addition to the healthy crop expectations for corn (we have seen a few above 13 billion bushels), some analysts are calling for a record soybean crop as well. August weather was good for both corn and beans, but we still are limiting our crop *yield* expectations based on a cooler summer where both crops received fewer growing degree days, particularly in July. In addition, the harvest window will not be extended this season as cooler September/October weather, and a higher threat of early frost, will limit the ability for a later harvest. As such, our yield estimates are up slightly for last week in corn, and they have remained the same for soybeans. Our corn yield number this week is in a range of **155.6 -158.0 bu/acre** range, while the **soybean** number has stayed the same, with the current yield estimate in a range between **41.5-43.5 bu/acre**. Activity should be fairly high this week in anticipation of the USDA crop production report, which will be released this Friday (11 Sept) at 8:30 am ET.
